Sometimes we need support in exploring our calling, discovering our purpose and offering what we can.


Sometimes we're sure we're in the right place at the right time.

What is Explore?

Explore is an opportunity for any member of the Methodist Church in Britain to take a breath, step back, and consider how they are called to respond to God's call through worship, learning & caring, evangelism or service.

You can sign up at any time of year and when you do so you will be offered:

An Accompanist	The purpose of being accompanied is so that you have someone who is a skilled listener, is a person of prayer, and who is outside of your normal life, to help you to reflect on what it is you are experiencing as a call from God.
Journaling	You are introduced to journaling because jotting things down in the moment (or soon after), and then looking back at them is proven to be a very helpful way for a lot of people to discern their vocations.
Shadowing	You are invited to shadow people who are serving God in roles which either you are considering, or in roles which will widen your horizons

Every September a 9-month course will start:

9 - month course	The course runs online, from September to May each year.
	This course is a 9 month commitment, by signing up, you are committing to be there, and engaged, for your peers' learning as well as your own.
